

# **Light Fixture Installation**



#### **Before Installation**


- 1. Please read these instructions before assembling or installing the product. **NOTE**: Installation by a licensed electrian is recommended.
- 2. Take out the fixture and the mounting package and make sure all parts are included. If any part is missing or damaged, please contact us.
- 3. All parts must be used as indicated in these instructions. Do not substitute any parts, leave parts out, or use any parts that are worn out or broken.
- 4. Do not disassemble the main body, as it has been installed & commissioned correctly & precisely before leaving the factory.
- 5. **IMPORTANT**: Turn off the main power at the circuit breaker and place the wall switch or pull chain in the "OFF" position.
- 6. Do not use bulbs with wattage greater than specified on this fixture.






#### **Installation Guide**









- Shut off power before installation. Fix the mounting strap (E) to the ceiling.
- Put on the sleeves (H) and screw in light bulbs (not included with the light fixture). Rest the glass shade (G) in place and secure with the screws (DD).
- 3. Feed the main wire (I) through centre tube (A, B). Screw the centre tube B into the metal frame (J) and thread the centre tube A into the centre tube B. Repeat to install centre tubes (C, D).







- 4. Insert the centre tube A and centre tube B assembly with main wire (I) through the canopy (F) and fix with washer and nut.
- Connect the main wire (I) with wire connectors (AA) to the corresponding wires in ceiling.
- 6. Attach the canopy (F) to the mounting strap (E) and fix with cap nuts (CC).

  Turn on the power and test.

## Troubleshooting

Problem	Possible Cause	Corrective Action
Fixture does not light.	<ol> <li>Fixture may be wired incorrectly.</li> <li>Worn or broken bulb.</li> <li>Lamp socket or LED transformer (if applicable) may go bad.</li> </ol>	<ol> <li>Check wiring.</li> <li>Replace bulb.</li> <li>Replace lamp socket or LED transformer (if applicable).</li> </ol>
Light bulb flickers.	<ol> <li>Switch Contacts are bad.</li> <li>Wire connections are loose.</li> <li>Light bulb socket may go bad.</li> </ol>	<ol> <li>Replace the switch.</li> <li>Check wire connections.</li> <li>Replace the socket.</li> </ol>
